

Cockatoo Island Camping Terms & Conditions

- Check-in at the Cockatoo Island accommodation office (located directed outside the arrival wharf – refer map) is from 2pm – 6pm on Friday 15th and check-out is by 11.00am on Mon 18th October. Those checking in on Saturday should make their way to the Cockatoo Island accommodation office as soon as they arrive on the island.
- Tents sleep up to two adults and two children and up to three adults (tent dimensions are 2.4 m x 2.4 m). The camping package includes: site hire, tent (Campmor Hennie Dome), 2 x mattresses, 2 x camping chairs, 1x lantern. Extra sleeping mats may be hired for a fee (subject to availability). Don't forget to bring your sleeping bag and pillow!
- Sites are allocated on the day of your arrival and are unpowered.
- Sites are 4 meters x 4 metres.
- Cost of transportation to and from the island is included in the ticket price from 9.30am Saturday 16th October and midnight Sunday 17th October on specially organised World's Funniest Island ferries departing from/arriving at King St Wharf. Travel outside these times in on the Sydney Ferries Cockatoo Island service <http://www.sydneyferries.info/timetables/cockatoo-island.htm>
- No cooking other than at the campground kitchen or island barbeques is permitted.
- Food is available for purchase from Muster Station Café on Friday evening and Monday morning and from the World's Funniest Island event food outlets across the weekend.
- Alcohol may not be brought onto the island, but is available for purchase from the Muster Station Café on Friday evening and from the World's Funniest Island Bars.
- Portable barbecues and compressed or liquid fuel is not permitted.
- Please depose of your camping rubbish in the World's Funniest Island event bins before leaving the island.
- Children must not be allowed to roam the island unsupervised especially after dusk.
- Swimming is now permitted in the slipway – wearing of sandals is highly recommended.
- Sorry fishing is not permitted.
- Animals (except guide dogs) are not permitted
- There is an ATM located at the World's Funniest Island bars on the Island during the event.

Please note that the campground has 24 hour security however you are urged not to leave valuables unattended. You may wish to bring a small padlock for your tent or keep valuables with you at all times.

Camping Features

- Campground kitchen with eight large electric barbeques, four sinks, fridge, microwave, instant hot water and seating and tables for up to 80 people
- Amenities block with solar-powered hot water showers, sinks and toilets for the use of campers only
- All camping facilities are designed to be fully accessible
- Fridge for storage of campers' food items
- Ice for sale
