TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- World's Funniest Island ("Event") is promoted by Australian Comedy Festival Pty Ltd ABN 69 139 271 721 ("Promoter")
- Tickets are sold and admission to the event is granted on the express condition that the holder is bound by these terms & conditions and any other the rules & regulations notified by the Promoter
- You must follow the reasonable directions of Event staff as required.
- The Event is an all age's event. Any persons under 16 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Any persons under 16 years of age, not accompanied by a responsible adult, will be refused entry to the event.
- Anyone found supplying or buying alcohol for a minor will be evicted from the event and may face criminal charges.
- The Promoter reserves the right to add, withdraw or substitute artists, vary the advertised program, seating arrangements and audience capacity and deny admission to the Event (including admission to a particular performance at the Event) with reasonable cause.
- Ticketholders acknowledge that there may be restricted capacities at some of the Event's stages/ venues. Once maximum capacity is reached in these areas there will be no further admissions. Your purchase of a ticket to the event does not guarantee admission to these areas in such cases.
- The services provided by the Promoter will be rendered with due care and skill to the extent required by section 74 of the Trade Practices Act 1974 and applicable similar State legislation. Apart from such statutory liability, the Promoter will not be liable or responsible for any damage or loss suffered or incurred by you when you enter or are on the Site, whether arising in tort, contract, bailment or otherwise – all such injury loss or damage to person or property is at your own risk.
- Venues and stages on and within the Site may operate a "No Smoking" policy. Ticketholders must comply with any such policies
- If you are collecting tickets at the ticket box, ID (valid driver's license or Proof Of Age card) must be shown.
- You agree to indemnify the Promoter against any loss or damage the Promoter may suffer arising out of your acts or omissions in relation to the Event (including but not limited to negligence or breach of these terms and conditions).
- Entry to the festival will be granted with presentation of a barcoded print-at-home ticket. You must present your ticket to the Event staff at entry gates where you will receive a wristband. The wristband must be worn at all times during the Event – failure to do so may result in your eviction from the Event site.
- No refunds or exchanges will be issued except in the case of a complete event cancellation prior to the Event (in which case the purchaser will receive a full refund of the ticket price and other industry imposed ticket charges). If the event is cancelled prior to its start, the Promoter will provide refunds to patrons who have purchased tickets for the cancelled event within 5 business days. Requests for refunds can only be made up to 4 weeks after notification of event cancellation. The Promoter is not liable for any damage, compensation, loss or expenses as a result of the event being cancelled, postponed, relocated or changed for whatever reason.
- There will be no replacement for lost, destroyed or stolen tickets.
- This ticket is strictly not for resale. Unlawful resale (or attempted resale) of a ticket is grounds for seizure or cancellation of that ticket without refund or other compensation.

- Professional audio or visual recordings of the event are prohibited without authorised media accreditation. Still cameras (not professional) are permitted but images may only be used for private purposes and not public display.
- Patrons consent to be included in film and sound recordings of the event and for these recordings to be used by the event organiser or Promoter in any medium or context without further authorisation by, or compensation to, you.
- It may be a condition of entry to the event that a search of person and/or their possessions be required at the time of entry to the venue in order to ensure the safety of the patrons. If you do not consent to such searches, you may be denied entry to the Site.
- No animals (other than guide dogs) admitted.
- You must ensure that you and your party act in an orderly manner when attending the Event. We may refuse entry or evict you if you or any of your party are behaving in a disorderly, offensive or inappropriate manner. The Event is a friendly, laid-back event, so please treat your fellow Event goers the way you would like to be treated.
- We reserve the right to evict patrons who disobey or break Responsible Service of alcohol legislation.
- Only alcohol purchased from bars within the site may be consumed at the Event. You are not permitted to bring any alcohol onto the Site and any found will be confiscated. Patrons wishing to consume alcohol must have photographic ID.
- Anyone found supplying or consuming illicit drugs will be evicted from the Event site and may face criminal charges.
- There will be no refund on any unused portion of tickets if you or your invitees are asked or forced to leave for any reason set out in these terms or conditions or if you decide not to attend any part of the Event.
- You are not permitted to display trading or signs at the Event site without prior consent of the Promoter.
- Footwear must be worn at all times on the Event site.
- The Promoter cares for the environment and community. Please be respectful and place any litter in the bins provided around the venue. Be waste and water wise - thank you
- You are responsible for checking all event information and ensuring you have purchased the right ticket for the right Event date. No refunds will be processed for patrons who have mistakenly purchased a ticket to the wrong date or made some other error in connection with their ticket purchase.
